EMERGENCY FIRST AID PROCEDURES

Eye Contact

Following eye contact, flush eyes immediately with plenty of water for fifteen minutes. Assure adequate flushing of the eyes by separating the eyelids with fingers. Get medical attention if irritation occurs.

Skin Contact

Inhalation

Move victim to fresh air if irritation occurs. Get medical attention.

Ingestion

First aid normally not required. Not expected to cause serious harm.
